Gutenberg's Biography (ex Wikipedia)

1394-1404: Birth of Johannes Gensfleisch, known as Gutenberg

1434: First works on printing in Strasbourg (especially printing of the Bible)

1436: Trial in Strasbourg (????)

1444-1448: Four years without news, where is he, what is he doing?

1448: Return to Mainz

1449-1450: Association of Gutenberg with Johann Fust

1451: Printing of a Donat Latin grammar

1452-1454: First book printed in series, the forty-two-line Bible

1454: Printing of a calendar, the Türkenkalender

1455: Fust vs. Gutenberg trial, Peter Schoeffer appears as a witness for the prosecution,

1457: Printing of the first book in colour by Fust and Schoeffer, the Psalmorum Codex

1465: Gutenberg is appointed nobleman to the Archbishop of Mainz, Adolf II of Nassau.

1468: On February 3, Gutenberg dies, bequeathing his invention to mankind.
